Glossary

Anticipate- regard as probable; expect or predict.

Aromatic-(of an organic compound) containing a planar unsaturated ring of atoms that is stabilized by an interaction of the bonds forming the ring. Such compounds are typified by benzene and its derivatives.

biodegradable- (of a substance or object) capable of being decomposed by bacteria or other living organisms.

Contamination-the action or state of making or being made impure by polluting or poisoning.

Environment-the surroundings or conditions in which a person, animal, or plant lives or operates.

Environmentally-in a way that relates to the natural world and the impact of human activity on its condition.

Exceptionally- to a greater degree than normal; unusually.

Flagrant- of something considered wrong or immoral) conspiracy or obviously offensive.

Flexible-capable of bending easily without breaking

Lead- a toxic condition produced by ingestion, inhalation, or skin absorption of lead or lead compounds, resulting in various dose-related symptoms including anemia, nausea, muscle weakness, confusion, blindness, and coma. Also called plumbism, saturnism.

Sewage-waste water and excrement conveyed in sewers.

Traditions-the transmission of customs or beliefs from generation to generation, or the fact of being passed on in this way.
